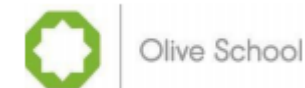

Impact Report

The grant has allowed our school to deliver a PE curriculum that provides our children with a range of learning opportunities in physical education and sports across both sites and to enhance our active provision during breaktimes and lunchtimes.

Our school also offers a wide range of opportunities for children beyond the requirements of the National Curriculum. There are a variety of sports enrichment clubs offered over the course of the year: football, gymnastics, netball, kick boxing, dance, and athletics. These are mostly run in termly blocks and available for children in KS1 and KS2 and take place after school.

The feedback from teachers indicates a significant impact in the form of an increase in:

- The expectations of children of their own performance
- Pupils' and Staff personal skill levels
- The understanding of the disciplines taught
- Participation by children in high quality lessons
- Children's skill levels
- Pupil participation in after school clubs in all year groups.

The impact of sports funding spending is as follows:
