IMPACT REPORT

For the academic year 2017/2018 the school received £16,000 plus an additional £10 per pupil in Years 1-5. The school will receive a total of: £ 20,500

The table below indicates how the PE and sport premium funding was spent, along with the impact that this had on increasing pupils' participation in sport and attainment in physical education in a sustainable way.

Activity/resource	Expenditure	Impact (effect of activity / resource on participation rates/progress/ attainment of groups of pupils) and sustainability
Transport for swimming	£8500	All children in Key Stage 2 to experience a term of swimming a year. More children to be able to swim proficiently.
After school enrichment clubs	£3000	Children able to participate in sporting enrichments which raise the profile of sport within the school.
Sports Day	£300	All children encouraged to participate in sports.
Sports Workshops and experience days	£6000	Children are able to participate in sports and outdoor activities they would not normally have the opportunity to – kayaking, horse riding.
Sports Equipment	£2000	To purchase a range of equipment to fulfil the requirements of the PE curriculum.
Transport for swimming	£8500	All children in Key Stage 2 to experience a term of swimming a year. More children to be able to swim proficiently.

Funding for competitions and equipment	£1000	enter or run more sport competitions
Apply for Sports Active Mark	£500	encourage pupils to take on leadership or volunteer roles that support sport and physical activity within the school
