The NSPCC visited the children to talk about keeping safe. The assemblies and workshops were engaging but also informative



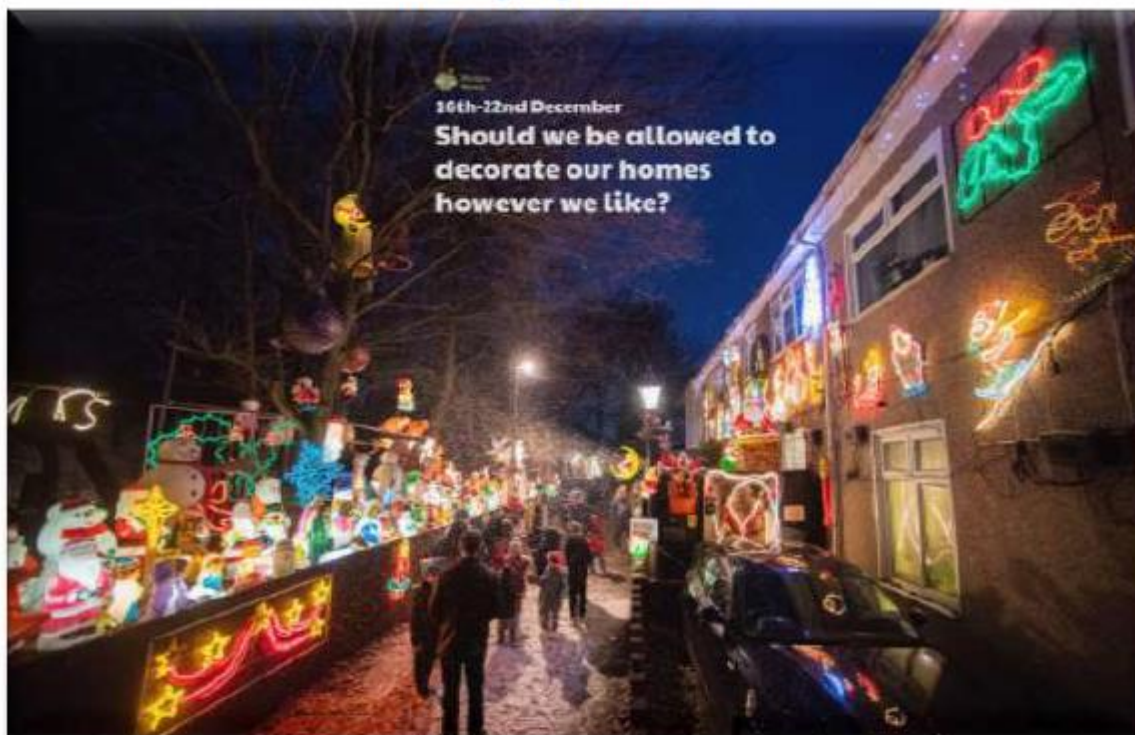
