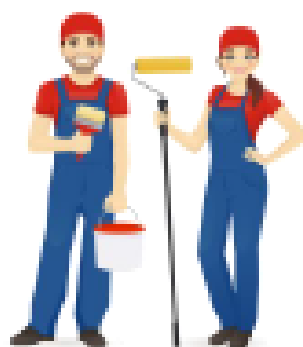
1b. Change the indirect speech in the sentences below into direct speech.
