Layout

There are two options when deciding the layout of your deeds:

1. You can either have different forms of deeds which relates to the STAR values on a daily basis.

<u>OR</u>

2. You can follow this structure:

Week 1 deeds based on Service Week 2 deeds based on Teamwork Week 3 deeds based on Ambition Week 4 deeds based on Respect





What the deeds need to relate to:

- STAR values, Hadiths & Ramadan.
- You can add questions/quiz to make it interactive.
- The deeds can relate to helping your family members out (e.g. help your parents/siblings out with household duties)
- The deeds can include you researching or reading about the conduct of the Prophet (PBUH) and explaining how you have implemented such conduct in your life e.g. forgiving your younger siblings if they have hurt you.





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
