- 'Allah has promised those who believe and do righteous deeds [that] for them there is forgiveness and great reward.' (Qur'an, 5:9)

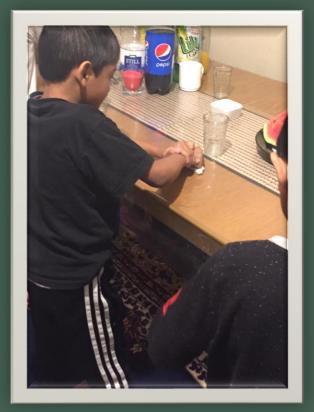
Instruction
