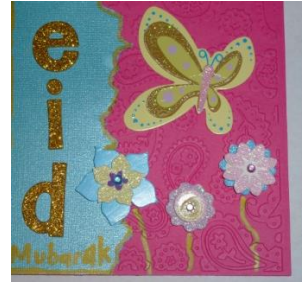


Year 1 Ramadan!

This is the last week of Ramadhan. In preparation for Eid, we would like the Year 1 children to make Eid cards. You can design and create your own cards.



Or decorate your card using paper flower hearts.

Paper flower hearts

You will need:

- Coloured paper
- Heart template
- Marker pen or pencil
- Scissors
- Glue

Method:

1. Trace heart shapes onto your coloured paper. You will need four hearts for each flower.
2. Carefully cut each of your hearts out. If you have used a dark marker to draw your hearts, trim any marker that you can see. This will help make your finished flower look beautiful.
3. Fold each of your hearts in half. Each heart will form one of your flower's petals and folding them will give them a lovely 3D effect.
4. Open your folded hearts back up and glue them together to form your flowers.



5. Add a pom pom to the centre of your flower. You could stick these flowers to decorate an Eid card or you could write some messages on the petals and give your flowers to someone special.

Write a poem about Eid inside your card.

Why don't you bake some Eid biscuits or decorate your house with creative decorations.
