Materials you will need:

- an empty square cardboard tissue box
- black and yellow construction paper
- acrylic paint or gold glitter/pens
- tape
- glue
- scissors
- ruler



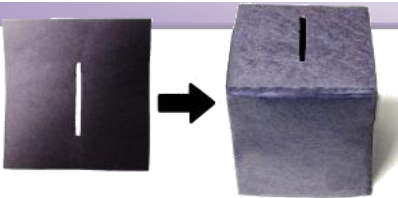
Making a Ka'bah charity box

Step 1:

Measure the box. Using the black paper, cut out 4 squares that are equal to the sides of the box and 2 squares equal to the top and bottom of the box. Make it a little bit longer than the box so when you stick it down, you can hide the edges of the box!

Step 2:

Measure the box. Once you have measured and cut out all the pieces of black paper, cover the whole box using tape or glue. Cut a slit on the top square of black paper on the centre of the box, large enough for money to be slipped through the hole at the top of the tissue box.



Step 3:

To make the Ka'bah design on your charity box, use yellow paper to cut out strips of paper. Make long strips to wrap around the top of your charity box. Use glue to hold the strip of the paper. Take the smaller strips and the circles and glue them underneath the single strip, forming the design around the entire box.



Step 4:

Lastly, using the yellow paper, cut out a small piece in the shape of a mihrab that will serve as the door. Congratulations, you just completed your Ka'bah charity box!
