$100\text{ml} = 1\text{cl}$,

$1000\text{ml} = 1\text{l}$

$1\text{cl} = 100\text{ml}$

$1\text{l} = 1000\text{ml}$

$10\text{mm} = 1\text{cm}$

$100\text{cm} = 1\text{m}$

$1000\text{m} = 1\text{km}$

$1000\text{g} = 1\text{kg}$

Perimeter is when you add up all the sides of a shape

Area is when you find the height and width of a shape and multiply them together. If it is a composite shape or a shape with more than 4 sides, you will have to split up the shape into two or three parts, work out the areas of those parts and then add up the areas (more info on this link
