SEN/D Parents Working Group

We are setting up a Special Educational Needs & Disability (SEN/D) working group at Olive School Hackney. This group will include the Principal, SENDCo, members of SLT, SEN/D Governor and parents from the school. The working group will meet once a month and focus on enhancing the provision of SEN/D in the school and to help promote SEN/D awareness to pupils, teachers and parents. Importance of Times Tables

We wish to encourage all parents to help their children learn the times tables. Every week, each class from Y2-Y6 will have a times tables test (five minutes). There are four different levels: bronze, silver, gold and diamond. The



teacher will assess where the children are so they can start at the correct level. Each child will get a paper copy of their challenge. Once they have completed one level (they must get every answer correct) three times, they will move to the next level. Once they have completed the diamond level in 5 minutes, the time will be reduced to 4 mins and then 3 mins. When they have completed the diamond level in 3 mins or less, they will get a mention in our assemblies. Teachers will be keeping a record of every children's progress.

Alternative Pick Up Arrangements

If you cannot pick up your child from school in person and have arranged for another person to pick up your child who is not on the official pick up list, then please ensure that you inform the school office in good time. Please do not wait until home time to do this as phone lines will be busy. Please try to inform the school office the day before or latest by the morning so that class teachers can be informed and there is no confusion during home time.
