New Building Update

Whilst we were expecting the practical completion and handover of the new school building today, it has once again been delayed by a few more days due to some tasks taking longer than expected. The new completion and handover date is now *Wednesday 28th October 2020*.

Staff have been working very hard this week not only delivering lessons and looking after their classes, but also packing up all resources into 500 crates and labelling furniture which will be moved to the new school building next week Tuesday and Wednesday.

All Reception teachers, Year 1 teachers, site staff and senior leaders will spend next Thursday (during holidays) unpacking and getting everything ready for our first day back on Monday 2^{nd} November 2020.

School Travel Plan

The Olive School is promoting sustainable and safe travel to and from its school and has prepared a detailed School Travel Plan. Click link to read the summary version: https://bit.ly/35rTJVA.

- It is strongly advised to check public transport times and routes at https://tfl.gov.uk/plan-a-journey/ where there is live bus and tube travel information to help plan the school journey.
- Lower Clapton Road in front of the school site and Urswick Road have several bus services and Route 106 is the most convenient to connect the new school site to Cazenove Road.
- Parents are advised to keep up to date with TfL proposals to introduce fares on buses for children (which the council and school are strongly against but TfL want to do this to recover lost revenue from the Coronavirus pandemic). As it stands, under 11's travel free on public transport in London when accompanied by an adult but need a Zip Oyster Card if they are travelling without an adult https://tfl.gov.uk/fares/free-and-discounted-travel/5-10-zip-oyster-photocard?intcmp=55572. Even if fares are introduced for children, LB Hackney can advise if your child is eligible for free travel based on home to school distance and household income. Contact LB Hackney through this link if you have concerns https://education.hackney.gov.uk/content/help-home-school-travel
- The new school site is Car Free and there is limited public parking spaces nearby. It is therefore strongly advised that parents and staff do not drive (if possible).

School Travel Plan Cont'd

- Vehicle stopping and parking restrictions and pay and display locations can be seen in detail on the LBH website https://www.hackneytraffweb.co.uk/main.html. Once the map opens then zoom in to the area near the school to see the traffic orders. In addition to the traffic restrictions on this map, there will be no access for school vehicles between 07:45 08:45 and 14:30 15:30 to St John's Church Road and the Church Access loop road. There will be Council and School Marshals to prevent this.
- Parents need to be considerate if they intend to drive and abide by parking restrictions. No stopping is allowed on Lower Clapton Road or Urswick Road near the school as these are Red Routes or bus stops. The streets to the south of the school are predominantly subject to resident parking permits and Sutton Square is a private road.
- Residents in the surrounding roads will complain and jeopardise the school operations if parents do not park responsibly.
- The School start and finish times have been planned to avoid the timings of the St John and James Primary School which is a 2 minute walk to the south of the School off the Churchwell Path.
- Where practical, it is strongly recommended that parents and pupils walk, scoot or cycle to and from school as this is proven to help children be more productive at learning, it helps the environment, mental and physical health and is cheaper than driving / parking.
- The school site includes sufficient and secure cycle / scooter parking accessed from St John's Church Road. As well as the TfL journey planner there are other walking and cycling journey planners such as https://walkit.com/ and https://www.cyclestreets.net/journey/ and there are lots of fun resources for school https://www.livingstreets.org.uk/walk-to-school/primary-schools locally LB from Hackney here https://drive.google.com/file/d/1V5TEjVxnRZn4wXJ6-hIXrA1ijWhNu3sk/view
- If your child is attending Breakfast Club then please enter from the front door on Lower Clapton Road. At all other start and finish times, parents should enter the rear playground from St John's Church Road at the rear of the school site.
- Parents must not congregate outside the school entrances or block pavements.
- Please be respectful of other pedestrians and cyclists and local residents at all times.
