Breakfast Menu

Each morning children are offered a healthy breakfast. This is usually a range of cereals, toast with spreads, fresh fruit, juice, and milk. Children will be active in the preparation of their food and will learn hygiene skills.

The registration form should detail any specific requirements your child has.

Routine

On arrival children should ensure they register themselves with staff on duty.

Children should then wash their hands and help to prepare their breakfast.

After 8:15am children will be taken to their classrooms by the Breakfast Club staff.

NOTE: Due to our lengthy waiting list, it is important that your child attends every day. If your child is absent/late more than twice a week, you will be notified that they have been removed from breakfast club. The space/s will then be given to those on the waiting list.
