Start of Summer Term

Our school will be re-opening for the new summer term on **Monday 19**th **April 2021**. The drop off and pick up timings will remain the same as usual throughout the month of Ramadan. The breakfast clubs on all three school sites will also remain open throughout Ramadan.

Attendance

At the end of the Spring term, our official attendance figure was **96.2%.** Well done to Reception and Year 2 who had the highest attendance. The attendance for Year 1 and 4 requires significant improvement as their attendance was below 96%. Our attendance target is over 97%.

To promote good attendance we shall be:

- Issuing special attendance certificates to all pupils with 100% attendance by the end of next week.
- Celebrating the class with the highest attendance in each year group. This will be published in the parent bulletin each week. Pupils in the class with the highest attendance will receive 3 Class Chart points.
- Inviting the class with the highest attendance in each year group to an end of summer term Circus Skills workshop in the last week of term.

Ramadan Arrangements

The blessed month of Ramadan is upon us. Please can you tell us if you would like your child to fast at school during Ramadan by completing this form – <u>CLICK HERE</u>.

We will try to provide a quiet space for pupils to use for quiet reflection or prayer during break and lunch times, however this may be limited due to Covid restrictions.

Pupils on free school meals who are fasting the whole day will be able to take their lunch home.

The school will be sensitive to pupils being lethargic and tired during lessons. For example, in PE, pupils who are fasting will be given less strenuous activity and more rest breaks.

There will be water and dates available in the school offices at all three sites. If any child who is fasting wishes to break their fast, then they will be sent to the school office where they will be given dates to eat and water to drink. They will be returned back to class soon after.
