It was an absolute pleasure to meet so many of you during the Meet & Greet sessions after school and the MacMillan Coffee Morning last week. We had an excellent turn out from parents. Thank you for taking part!

OPTION 2

On the Scholastic website, select 'I am paying for books from a Wish List'. Enter your details, along with the total amount you are paying for your books. Once payment is complete, forward your payment reference and details of the books you have purchased to your Book Fair Organiser at school. They will arrange getting your brand new books to you!



OPTION 3
