Ramadhaan Giving Programme

During this year's Ramadhaan Giving Programme pupils, parents and staff will raise funds to alleviate suffering in the UK, Syria and Afghanistan. The programme will be delivered in partnership with *Shine Charity*.

There will be three strands to this year's Ramadhaan Giving Programme:

1. Supporting the Star family in the UK

We will support our local communities around our school through the provision of food vouchers and food packs to impoverished families.

2. Supporting the Star family in Lebanon

In Lebanon, Syrian refugee families lack shelter, food, schooling and access to basic medical care. The Lebanese Government struggles to provide adequate support due to the economic hardship in their country. Through this Ramadhaan Giving Programme, we will fund a school for Syrian refugee children in Lebanon.

3. Supporting our Star family in Afghanistan

In Afghanistan, following the change in government and the removal of international financial assistance, many families are suffering with acute hunger. Through this Ramadhaan Giving Programme, schools will fund food programmes across the country.

We are all encouraged to compete in the good deeds and so we will be setting weekly challenges for each year group. With your help, we can make a big difference to the lives of so many needy people both in the UK and around the world.
