## Extreme Heat Warning

The Met Office has issued a red extreme heat warning for areas of England on Monday 18 July and Tuesday 19 July, including London. The red warning indicates an exceptional hot spell of weather leading to widespread impacts on people and infrastructure.

The Department of Education is not advising schools or other settings to close but are advising schools to make adequate. Our school will remain open on Monday and Tuesday. We will putting the following in place:

- All parts of the school building will be have air conditioning throughout the day.
- All pupils can wear non-school uniform encouraging encouraging children and young people to wear loose, light coloured clothing and sunhats with wide brims.
- pupils will go straight to class when gates open in morning from 8:05am.
- pupils will remain in class during all playtimes including lunch play. Pupils will not use the playground and will remain indoors.
- Pupils will be kept hydrated through the day with cold water available in all classes.
- After school pick up time will be reduced to 2:30pm - 2:45pm
  - 2:30pm - Reception and Year 1
  - 2:35pm - Year 2 and Year 3
  - 2:40pm - Year 4 and 5
  - 2:45pm - Year 6
- All pupils will receive an ice pop before leaving their class for after school pick up.
- There will be no after school clubs.
- All vigorous physical activity will be avoided.
