#### **After School Pick Up Timings**

The revised timings have made a significant difference to the after school pick up experience. Thank you to parents for their cooperation and making it a success. From Monday:

- All Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 pupils who have siblings in Year 4, Year 5 or Year 6 will be kept in class and brought down to the playground at 2:50pm. This is to avoid any child having to wait longer than 10 mins.
- If they have siblings in any other year group, they will come down to the playground at the normal time.
- Please remember, the new pick-up timings are:
  - Reception & Year 1 2:30pm
  - Year 2 & Year 3 2:40pm
  - Year 4 & Year 5 2:50pm
  - Year 6 3:00pm
- Please collect your child at the correct time and avoid coming late as lateness contributes towards creating large crowds.
- Please avoid distracting any staff members who are on duty which includes class teachers and members of SLT. If staff are talking to parents, then they cannot supervise the children properly.

#### **Attendance**

This week's overall attendance was **95%.** We are still 2% lower than our target attendance. Well done to *Year 4* and *Year 6*. To reward good attendance, from next week, our *Class Charts* system will automatically give children **3 points** if they have attended school for the whole week (5 days). This means that any pupils with poor attendance are unlikely to receive a *Golden, Silver* or *Bronze* ticket at the end of each half term.
