Lockdown Practice Drill

We conducted a lockdown practice drill which lasted 2 mins on *Wednesday*. A lockdown is the opposite to a fire evacuation. In an emergency, instead of leaving the school building we stay in the school building, in our classrooms/offices, and lock the doors. The purpose of a lockdown is to keep us all safe if there is something or someone dangerous inside the school (not a fire). Our lockdown procedures aim to minimise disruption to the learning environment whilst ensuring the safety of all learners, staff and visitors.

We conducted an assembly for all pupils before the lockdown practice drill to explain to pupils what a lockdown is and what to do in the event of a lockdown, and to reassure pupils that there was nothing for them to worry about.

We will be conducting another lockdown practice drill in 2-3 weeks' time. We will inform all parents beforehand and deliver another assembly to all pupils explaining any updates to our procedures.

One important update that will be communicating to pupils is that if they are in the toilets when the lockdown siren sounds, they must quickly go into the nearest classroom rather than staying inside one of the toilet cubicles.

I hope you have all had a good week.

Thank you to parents who attended our Parent Coffee Afternoons on *Mondays*. Please continue to attend these important weekly sessions to develop your partnership with our teachers.

I am very concerned about the attendance in some classes. If your child is not in school, they will miss a lot on their learning. We have end of term assessments for all subjects in two weeks' time to check how much progress all pupils have made this term.

Reception pupils also have *Early Learning Goals (ELGs)* to meet by June 2023. If they are absent from school, there is very little chance they will achieve *Good Level of Development (GLD)*. This could impact on their entire primary education. Please ensure your child is in school every day so they are not missing out on any learning and perform well in the upcoming end of term assessment tests.

Reporting Absences

- If your child has an appointment in the morning and will not be in for morning registration, please inform the office by either calling 0207 683 7436 or sending an email to attendance@olivehackney.staracademies.org
- Please try to book all medical appointments after school however, if you need to collect your child from school early due to an appointment and you are aware beforehand either via letter from GP/ Hospital etc please inform the office and class teacher in advance. You can send in a handwritten note with your child to give to the teacher stating what time you will be collecting your child. If no note is provided, there may be a delay in your child coming to the office. Medical evidence will be requested to be seen by office staff before releasing your child.
- If an emergency has occurred and you need to collect your child, please call up the office whilst on your way. If you do not call-in advance, there may be a delay in your child coming to the office.

Reception 2023 Admissions

- Parents of children joining Reception in September 2023 must complete their local authority's application form by 15th January 2023. Please complete the form fully and include details of siblings and/or if you are employed at the school, where appropriate.
- If you are applying as a Staff member for your child to start school either Primary or Secondary, please could you let *Ms. Juveriyyah Bismillah* know if you are applying for your child's admission into any of our (STAR) schools for admission in September 2023. Please include your full name, Position held in school and start date, your child's full name, date of birth, full address, and the name of the school for which you are applying and remember to submit this information before the deadline for applications (Primary- 15th January 2023).

- Please note, you need to still apply through your Local Authority's application forms clearly stating you are a Staff Member with 1st Preference for your chosen school.
- You will only be notified of the outcome of your application on National Offer Day. 
<u>General</u>
