#### **Persistent Lateness**

Unfortunately, many parents routinely come very late when picking up their child(ren) from school. Many staff members including site staff, senior leaders and the Principal are often left waiting at the school gates in the cold for more than an hour with the same parents arriving late with the same excuses. This is unacceptable, unfair, and contrary to our faith ethos and our home school agreement.

The main reason why many after school clubs have not restarted back is because many parents were picking up their children late. We are no longer prepared to stay behind after school standing around in the cold.

Despite accommodating siblings, many Year 6 pupils (and their siblings) who attend daily booster classes are also being picked up very late every day. From next week, we will be removing pupils from booster classes if they cannot be picked up on time. Please pick up your child(ren) on time.

#### **Holidays During Term Time**

- Holidays during term time are not permitted. Only in cases of an emergency will an authorized holiday be approved. You will also be asked to provide evidence of flights and medical documents, if necessary, failure to do so could lead to a fine. Please also be aware that a Leave Of Absence (LOA) should always be filled out and submitted to the office at least 2 weeks prior to travelling.


