School Street Extension Consultation

Some parents have asked about how they can provide feedback on the new School Street extension to SS31 which is being implemented under an experimental traffic order for a maximum period of 18 months. Formal consultation is being run concurrently with the experimental period and any representations made within the first 6 months of operation will be considered as part of the decision to amend, remove or make permanent the scheme.
